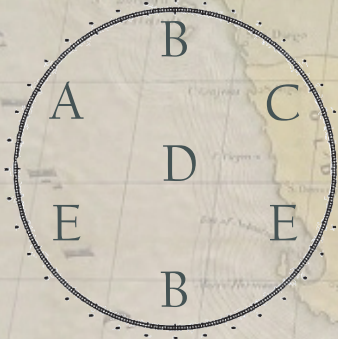


ACADIA

- A - Coleus Kong Rose (U)
- B - Iresine Purple Lady (T)
- C - Begonia Dragon Wing Red (M/T)
- D - Impatiens Fanciful Pink (M)
- E - Dichondra Silver Falls (T)



Plant Habits: U - Upright M - Mounding T - Trailing



DIRECTIONS

- Fill container with potting mix
- Position plants on soil to determine placement
- Dig a hole, place plants and fill
(Tip: start with the center plant and work outward)
- Repeat with remaining plants
- Compact soil to remove air pockets
- Water
- Check daily for watering needs
- Fertilize regularly

- 16" CONTAINER (69434)
- 5-7 PLANTS PER 16" CONTAINER
- POTTING MIX
- SLOW RELEASE FERTILIZER
- HAND SHOVEL OR TROWEL
- GLOVES
- WATERING CAN
